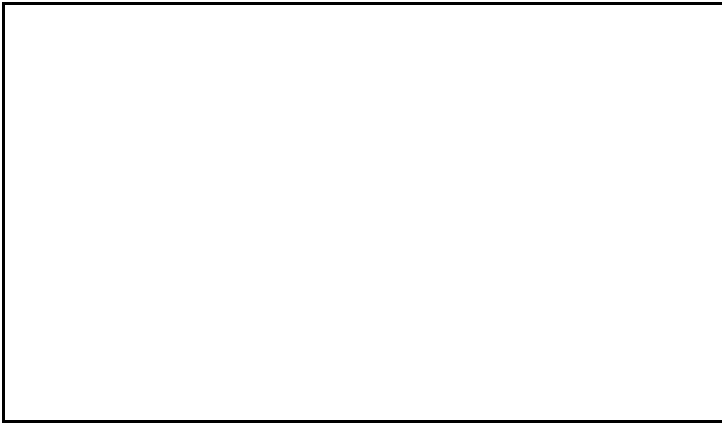

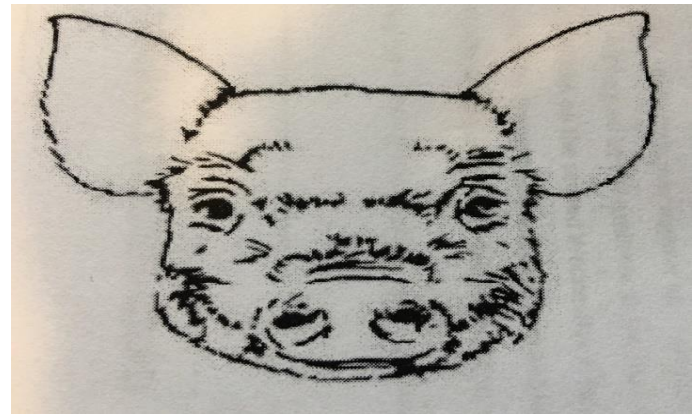
Left side view

Hair sample must be turned in with completed form. Pull hair from pig, place in ziplock bag, attach bag to form.

By signing below, you agree that, should your pig(s) become ill or show signs of any illness, they may be quarantined and deemed terminal. Terminal means the animal may not go back to the farm but go directly to a packer. The fair board at any time may declare all swine terminal and no animals

will be allowed to return to the exhibitors farm, they will go directly to a packer. Exhibitor will be responsible for all processing fees.
