1. Refer to the appropriate sections in the Project Requirements for a complete set of rules pertaining to Dairy Goat projects
2. All goats must be in the exhibitor's possession and continual care by May 1, or if not born by May 1, the dam must be in the exhibitor's possession and continual care by May 1
3. All dairy goats need to have a permanent identification in their ears or tail (La Mancha) by the second Wednesday in May
4. Dairy goats not having any permanent identification must be brought to the Athens County Fairgrounds the second Wednesday in May between 5:00 – 8:00 p.m. to be tattooed
5. Identification will be checked prior to dairy goat show.
6. **It is the 4-H member's responsibility to return this completed form by the second Wednesday in May**
